§1002.33, Fla. Stat.

Charter School law—combination of State and

Federal Law

Fla. Admin. Code R. 6A-6.0786



- §1002.33, Fla. Stat. created Charter Schools; Fla. Admin. Code R. 6A-6.0786 created a standard contract to begin negotiations
- Note: any changes to the standard contract made by the District must be for good cause, presumed to be unreasonable

Financial Accountability

- Basis for funding
- Annual budget and audit
- Monthly/quarterly reports



Governance

- Meetings held in compliance with Sunshine Laws
- Role of Governing Board/membership
- Requirements for Governing Board members (i.e., fingerprinting)

Staying on track— Reporting



- Pre-Opening (i.e., Student Code of Conduct, Policies and Procedures)
- Monthly (i.e., financials, board minutes)
- Annually (i.e., Student Achievement Report, Projected Enrollment)

Section 11—Charter School Contract



Game plan

- > READ the whole contract at least once per year
- FAMILIARIZE the Governing Board with the Contract one Section at a time
- >SCHEDULE important dates
