

## A Great Opportunity for Charter Schools

Florida Charter School Alliance is thrilled to announce the creation of the School Leaders Fellowship in partnership with the Florida Department of Education through the U.S. Department of Education's CSP grant. The goal of the School Leaders Fellowship is to develop a robust pipeline of strong, effective, and visionary charter school leaders. This tuition-free Fellowship was designed specifically for individuals working at a public charter school who are passionate about education and interested in leading a high quality school in a high-need area.

## More about the program:

- The first cohort was selected in summer 2021 and will begin the program in October 2021.
- Fellows will meet monthly: three times in person and four times virtually over the course of seven months –
   October 2021 to April 2022.
- Sessions will provide Fellows with an overview of the Florida charter school movement and will cover a full range of topics essential to school leaders including Charter School Law, Parent and Community Engagement, District Relations. Charter School Operations and School Finances.
- Priority will be given to:
  - Charter schools in operation for 5 years or less
  - Charter schools that receive Title I funds
  - Charter schools that are unable to provide high quality professional development opportunities for high caliber individuals interested in becoming future charter school leaders

The next fellowship cohort will be selected through an application process
