

A Great Opportunity for Leaders of New Charter Schools

Florida Charter School Alliance is thrilled to announce the creation of the School Leaders Fellowship in partnership with the Florida Department of Education through the U.S. Department of Education's CSP grant. The goal of the School Leaders Fellowship Program is to develop a robust pipeline of strong, effective, and visionary charter school leaders. This tuition-free Fellowship was designed specifically for individuals who are passionate about education and interested in leading a high quality school in a high-need area, working at a charter school in operation for 5 years or less, and have applied for and/or received a grant or sub grant from the Florida Department of Education.

- The 3 Components of School Leaders Fellowship Program:
 - 1. The Mentorship Component will assist Fellows in the development of skills required to perform administrative duties and to increase capacity for leading a charter school.
 - 2. The monthly Coursework Component will provide an opportunity for Fellows to meet over the course of seven months. Sessions will provide Fellows with an overview of the Florida charter school movement and will cover a full range of topics essential to school leaders including Charter School Law, Parent and Community Engagement, District Relations, Charter School Operations and School Finances.
 - 3. The Capstone Project Component is designed as an opportunity for SLF Fellows to demonstrate their understanding of the Florida Principal Leadership Standards that form the foundation for school leader preparation and which are set forth as Florida's core expectations for effective school administrators.
