CURRENT CMS GUIDELINES

Each school must be enrolled to participate

Staff training must be conducted

Participate in time studies using samples or time logs (Quarterly)

Cost determination and allocations must be performed

Submit a quarterly Medicaid Administrative Claim

Comply with AHCA and CMS monitoring and audits



Must be eligible on date of service.

Have Medicaid services listed in IEP

Qualified healthcare professionals are required.

Be entitled to services under IDEA

Under the age of 21







Student Registration

Collect student information, can be imported from Power Schools.

Updated Annually



Coding

Certified coders review documentation for compliance and follow all Medicaid coding quidelines. Communicates items to be reviewed/updated by Provider.

Within 2 Business Days of Receipt



Obtain annual parent consent and student Medicaid/Private Insurance information. Enroll in the Random Moment Time Study (RMTS) Medicaid training and follow Admin requirements.

Occurs Annually



Work denials and generate appeals.

Occurs Daily & Weekly



Clearinghouse

Monitor submitted claims for rejections.

Accounts Receivable

Work unpaid claims by following up with Medicaid and Private Insurance.

Apply payments received from Medicaid and Private Insurance.

Manager, ask questions, review additional service options.
